 Fais comme les Français.
AS ...AS est utilisé pour comparaison/équivalence:
 Sue is as nice as her mother. Sue est aussi gentille que sa maman.
LIKE est utilisé pour les comparaisons uniquement quand un nom/pronom suit: We lived like kings.
LOOK LIKE: ressembler à
 He looked like Frankenstein.
HOW est un mot interrogatif: comment? De quelle façon?
 How did you manage it?
