There are probably more than **a-hundred / 10 million** different species of animal.

Mammals are the only animals with **four legs / fur or hair**. All mammals drink **beer / milk** from their mothers when they are **sleepy / young**. Bats, whales and monkeys are mammals – **but you are not! / and so are you!**



Birds are the only animals with **feathers / heads**. They are **brought by the stork / born from eggs**. Birds have strong wings, but some birds, like the ostrich and the **eagle / penguin**, cannot fly.

Most reptiles live on **ice / dry land**. Their skin is covered with tough, dry scales. Lizards, **rabbits / snakes**, crocodiles and turtles are all reptiles.

Amphibians are born in the **cabbage / water**, but when they **die / grow up**, they can live on land. Frogs, toads and newts are all amphibians.

Fish live in **snow / water**. Their bodies are covered in scales and they have **life jackets / fins** to help them swim. Fish breathe **with snorkels / through gills**.

Arthropods **do not have bones / have boots**. Instead they have a hard skin or **helmet / shell** on the outside of their body. Arthropods have at least **three pairs of / hundred** legs. **Insects / lions** are the most common arthropods.

Molluscs have a soft **gun / body**, with a hard shell around it. Molluscs have no legs, but many have a kind of 'foot' to help them **move about / fly around**. An octopus is a mollusc with its shell inside its **briefcase / body**.
