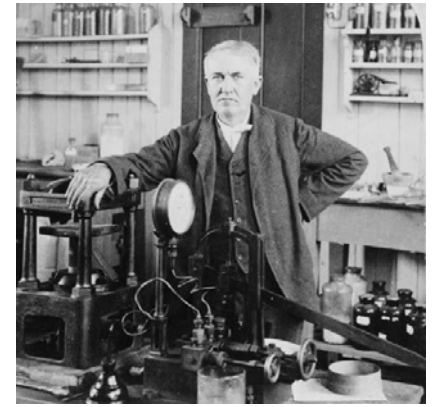


Thomas A. Edison was born in Ohio in 1847. He was the greatest inventor of all time. He made more than a thousand inventions. Many of his inventions used the new and amazing power of electricity.



Edison's teachers couldn't teach him, because he knew too much and asked too many questions. So he left school and learnt by himself at home. At the age of 12 he started a newspaper on board a train.

In 1876, Edison set up his own laboratory. He invented a new microphone to make the telephone work better. In 1877, he made a phonograph, a kind of record player. His first recording was the poem „Mary had a little lamb“. In 1879, he made an electric light bulb.

Edison became a rich man. He died in 1931.
